Elmo Funk “Ideal of Service” Award June 15, 2010

The Elmo Funk “Ideal of Service” Award was established in 1969, the same year our Club celebrated its golden anniversary. The Award recognizes a distinguished active Rotarian who distinguishes himself or herself in a manner that demonstrates the Object of Rotary, which is to encourage and foster the “Ideal of Service”. The 2010 Award goes to **Stan Guilkey**.

Stan has been an active Rotary Club member since 1987. He has served on the Board, chaired the speech contest for 10 years, chaired the scholarship committee for many years, helped with the Erskine Baseball Award, donated to the Rotary auctions to raise scholarship money, and helped with Rotary’s “Trees for Tomorrow” project for several years.

In the community, Stan has been very involved with the Anderson Historical Preservation Commission since 1976, serving as President and Vice President. He contributed to setting many of the guidelines for the commission. As well, Stan has served on the Board of Directors of the Historic West 8th Street Neighborhood Association. During this time he helped organize and run the Historic Gaslight Festival.

Stan has served on St. John’s Health Systems Development Board and served as a volunteer at the first Pain Webber Wine Tasting Event. Other organizations/boards in which Stan has been involved include the Anderson Fine Arts Center Board of Directors, Board of the YMCA, Rural Urban Design Assistance Team, The White River Development Commission, the Mayor’s Arts and Cultural Commission, the 20/20 Foresight Project, and the Site Building Management Committee for Robinson School.

Stan is an excellent example of a person who believes one can and should give to the community in which they live to help make it a better place for the greater community. One only needs to look around the city of Anderson to see places where Stan’s contributions have made a difference!
