## President Debbie Webb, “2009-2010 Rotary Year in Review & Installation of New Officers” June 29, 2010

President Debbie shared the highlights of her year as president and acknowledged all the Rotarians who embodied Rotary’s Ideal of Service to the club. She thanked all by name for their volunteer service this year: as board members, committee chairs, committee members, greeters, meeting volunteers (of the Prayer, pledge or 4-Way Test/ Rotary Moment). Debbie said, “It has been an honor and a privilege to serve as your president this year. I am truly grateful for this year and the opportunity to attend the RI Convention in Birmingham, England.

She added, “Attending a district conference and an international convention changes your entire perspective about Rotary and its impact around the world. I remember my week in the land of Harry Potter, Shakespeare, Henry VIII. The RI convention was an inspiring and fabulous experience that had me pumped for my year. I remember my excitement and resolve to share the respect and opportunity to make a difference in our community and around the world.”

She recounted the many proud moments of her presidency: receiving a The District Simplified Grant and implementing the Minds in Motion Literacy Project for all primary schools for Anderson Community Schools, including hosting 99 teachers at a Minds-in-Motion training session; support of the International projects including the Water is Life Project, the District Wide Haiti Relief and Mission Haiti Midwest; 23 Members & Interactors attending the District Wide Meeting with Rotary International President Nominee Ray Klingensmith in Muncie; the Success of the Annual Funds Campaign and surpassing the Polio Plus Challenge raising \$8008, including \$5650 for TRF and \$2358 for Polio Plus; increasing the giving per member from \$9.56 to almost \$48 per member, having 22 first-time givers to the RI foundation and 81 members who gave a gift to either the TRF, Polio Plus or both; the nine Rotarians who became Paul Harris Fellows or Multiple Paul Harris Fellows: the twelve new members inducted into the club with a net gain of four new members for the year; and the 105th Anniversary Celebration and Purple Pinkie Day on February 23rd.

She traced those proud moments back to the club members who answered the call to service. She went on to express her appreciation to every member for their dedication and commitment to the Anderson Rotary Club and for their generosity in supporting the programs of Rotary International.

Debbie, commented that after three years of coming to Rotary early, it will be a pleasant change to sit back and enjoy my lunch and the program. Last August, District Governor Elect Salim Najar asked Debbie to become an assistant governor for the 2010-2011 year. Her new role begins on July first.

Again I wish to say thank you for making my year as president so rewarding. It has been a time and experience that I hold close to my heart. In ringing the bell for the last time, Debbie stated, I now officially bring this Rotary Year to a close. It has been an honor and privilege to serve along side you.
