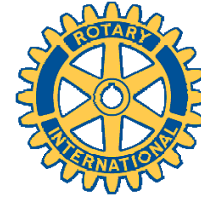


The Anderson YMCA is launching a 5.5 million dollar Capitol Campaign.

These homes have been built by Rotarians in 30 different countries with the assistance of 487 grants from the Rotary Foundation. More than 200 clubs in 27 different countries served as international partners for "Low Cost Shelter" projects

The Rotary Foundation has since the inception of this program provided a total of \$8,124,694 as grants. Typically this amount was matched by international Rotary partners and Rotary host partners. Club and district contributions in the case of both host club partners and international partners varied with combinations of cash and volunteer manpower.

A typical Low Cost Shelter contains two very small rooms, has a concrete floor as an improvement from dirt and a metal roof with no inside plumbing. Considering the average cost per "Low Cost Shelter" this has provided approximately 5,500 such homes.

We can all be pleased that so many families in so many countries whose lives have been improved through the efforts of Rotarians in many nations where keeping dry and out of the wind is a first step to a possible better life.

Rotarians serve wherever and however they are able. Providing "Low Cost Shelters" is one of the ways.

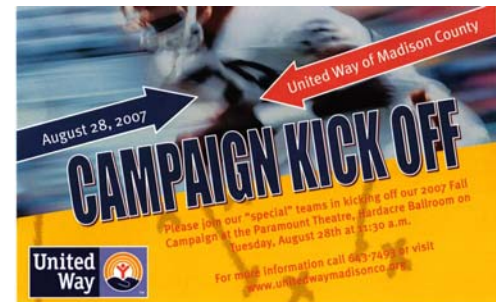
